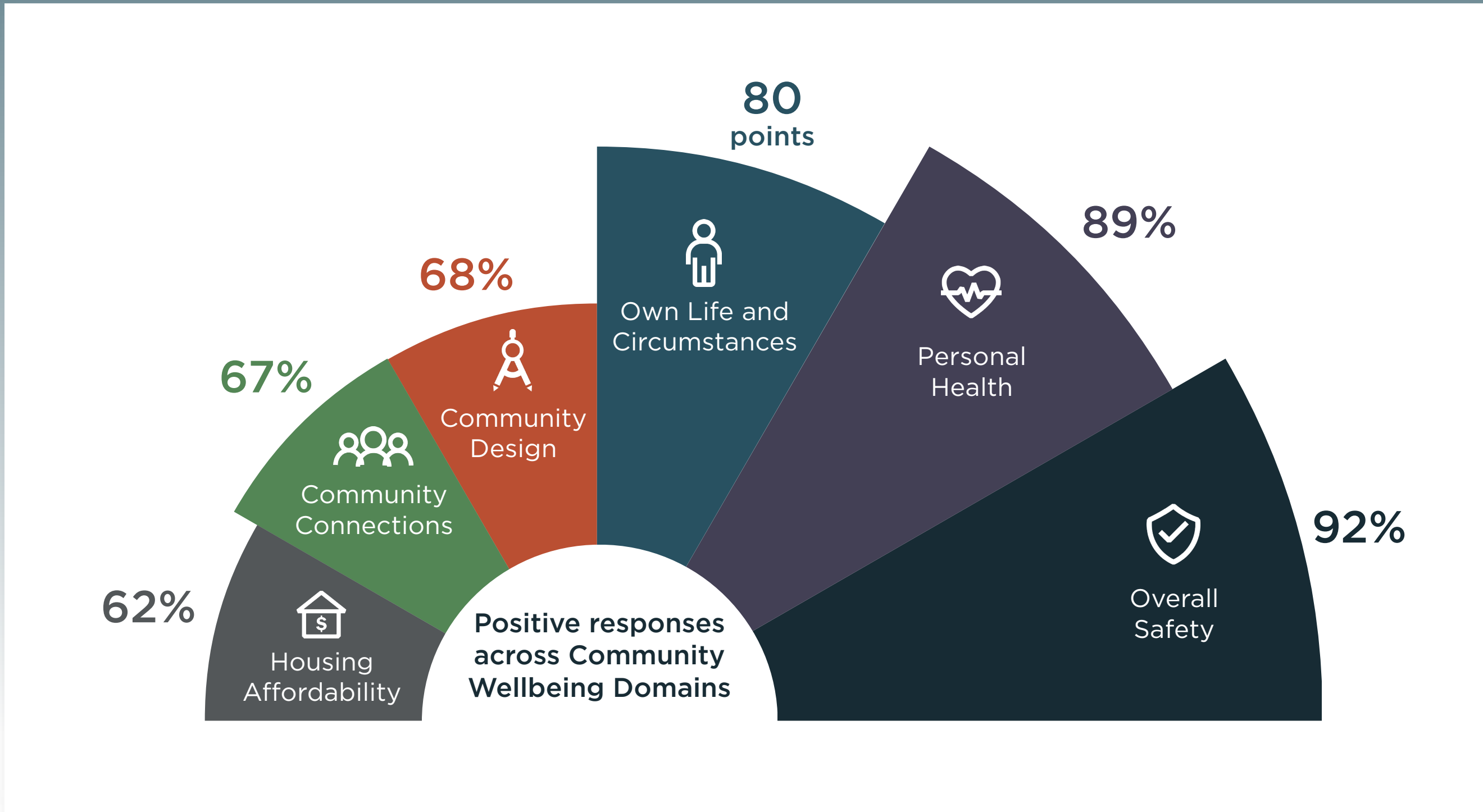

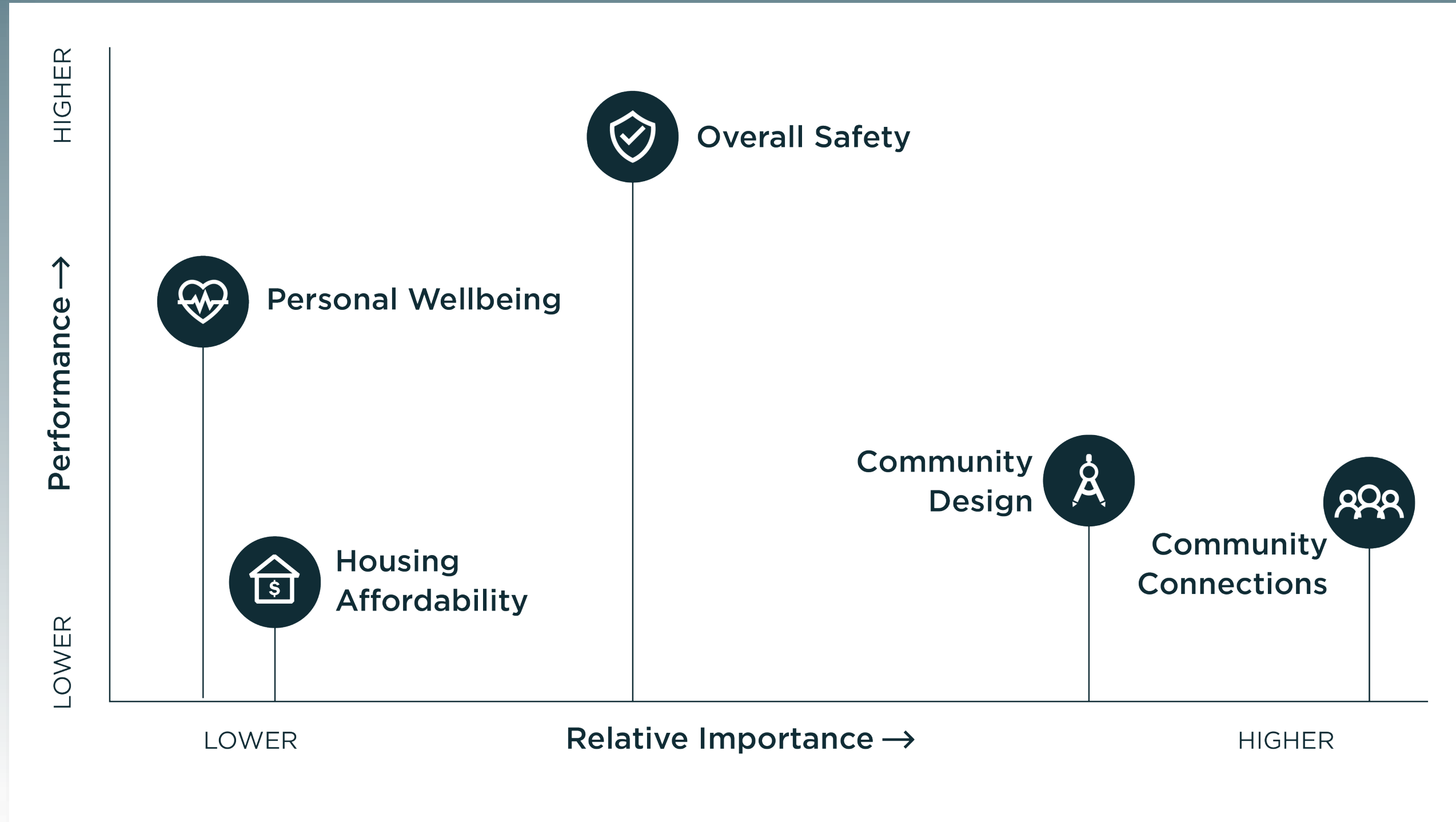

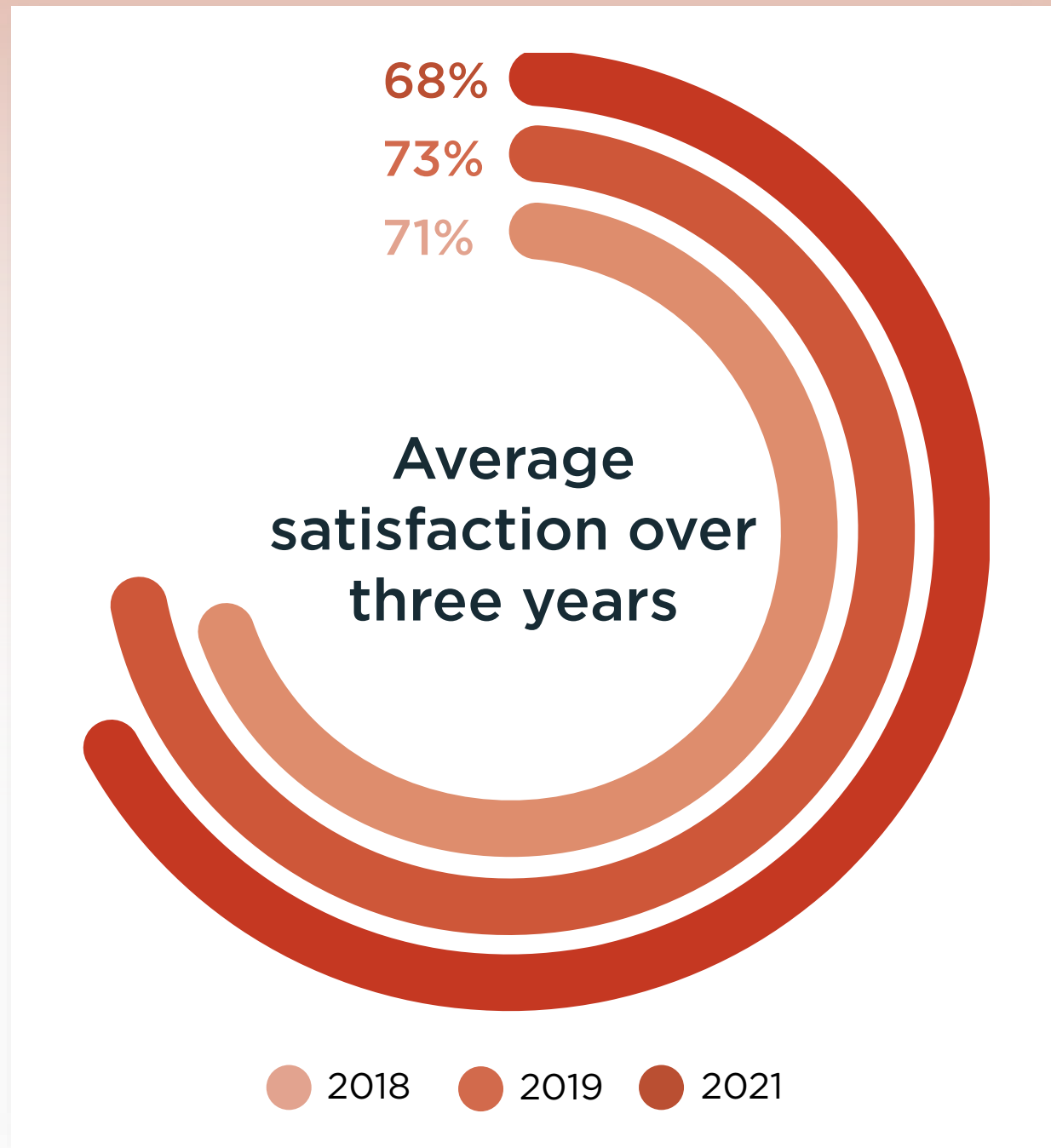


Drivers of overall satisfaction for 2021

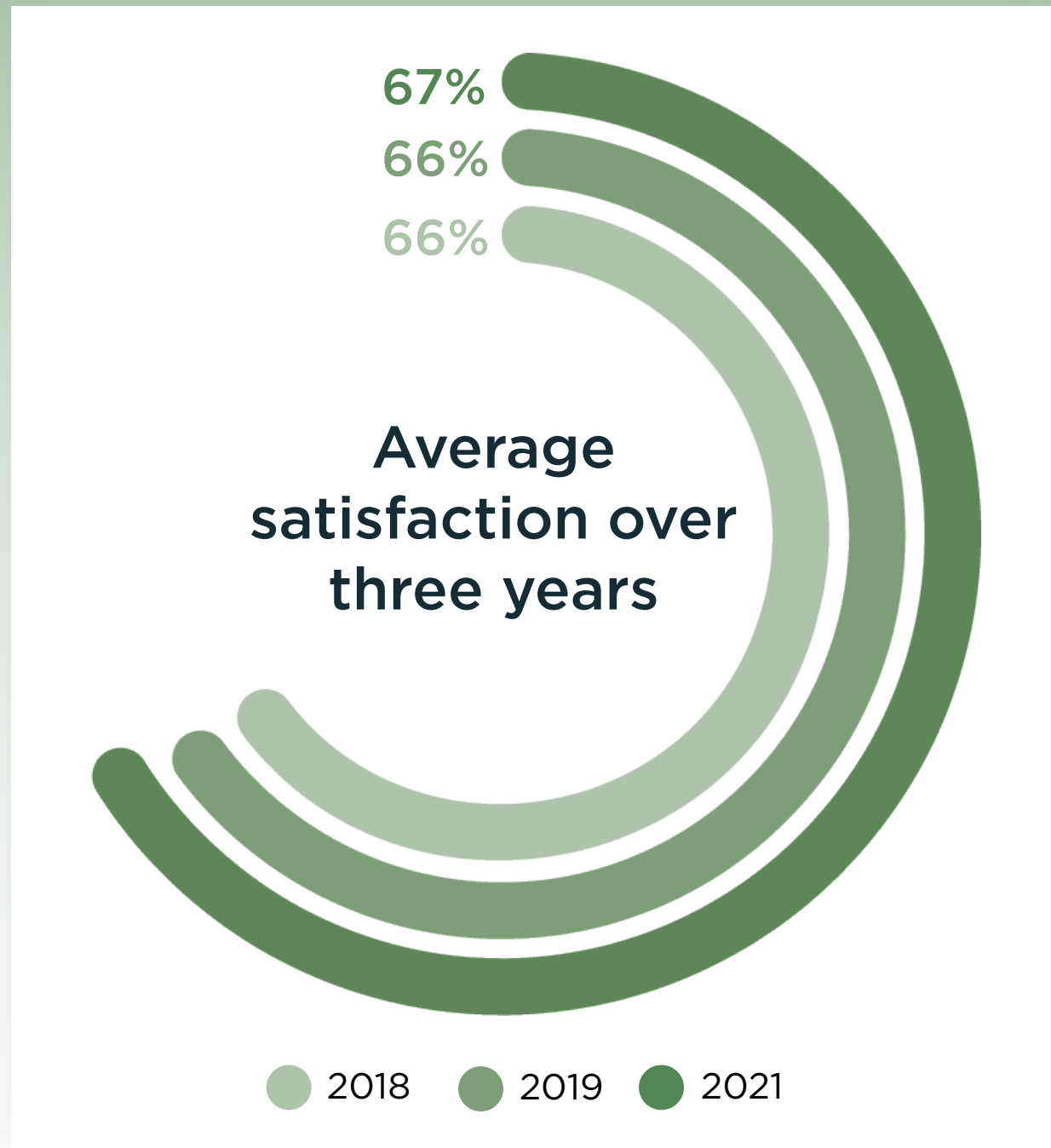

Personal Wellbeing Index results show Landcom respondents largely scoring above the 2020 NSW average on the Personal Wellbeing Index (80 points compared to a norm of 77)*.

was the average rating of residents satisfaction with their personal relationships



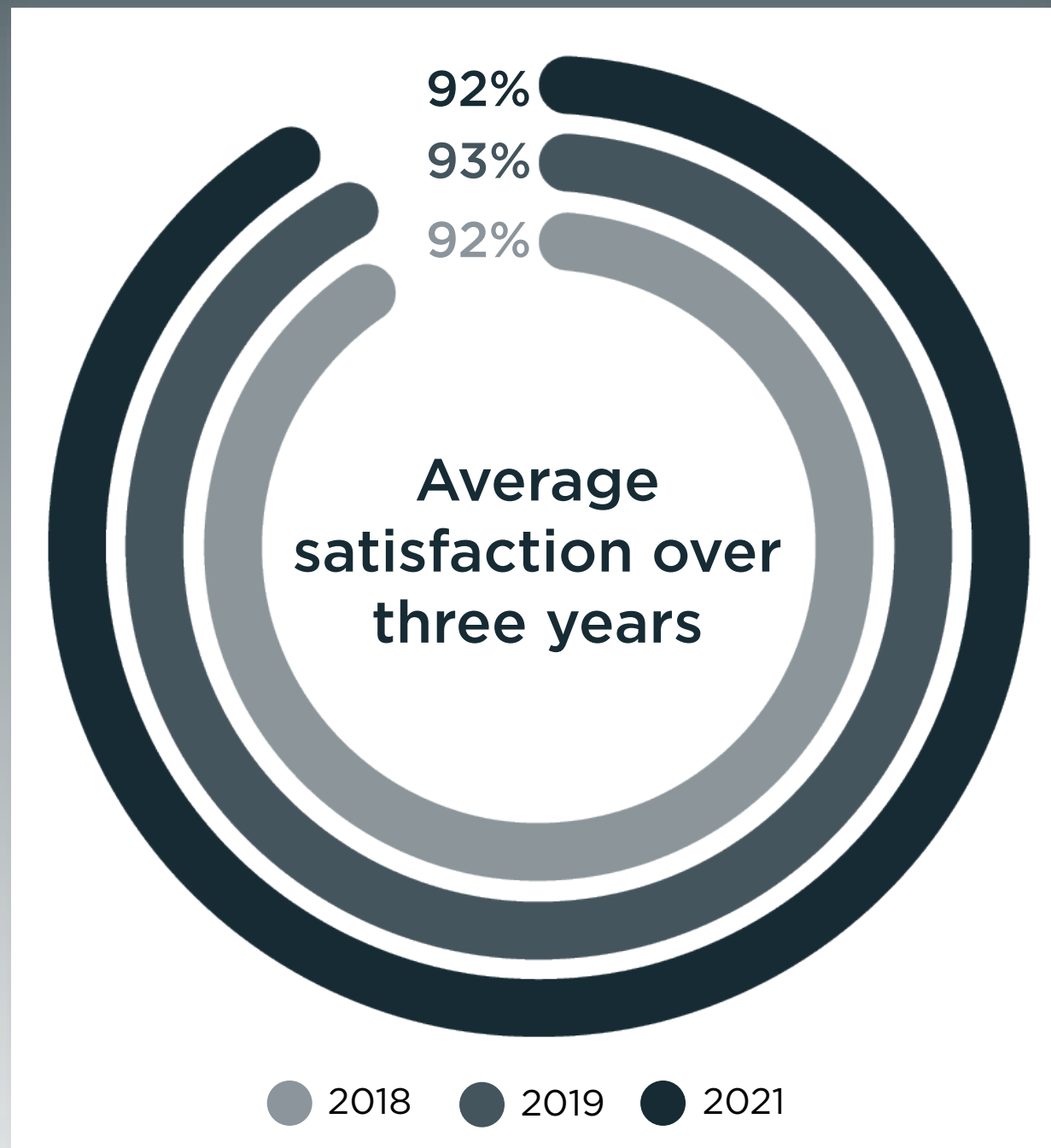

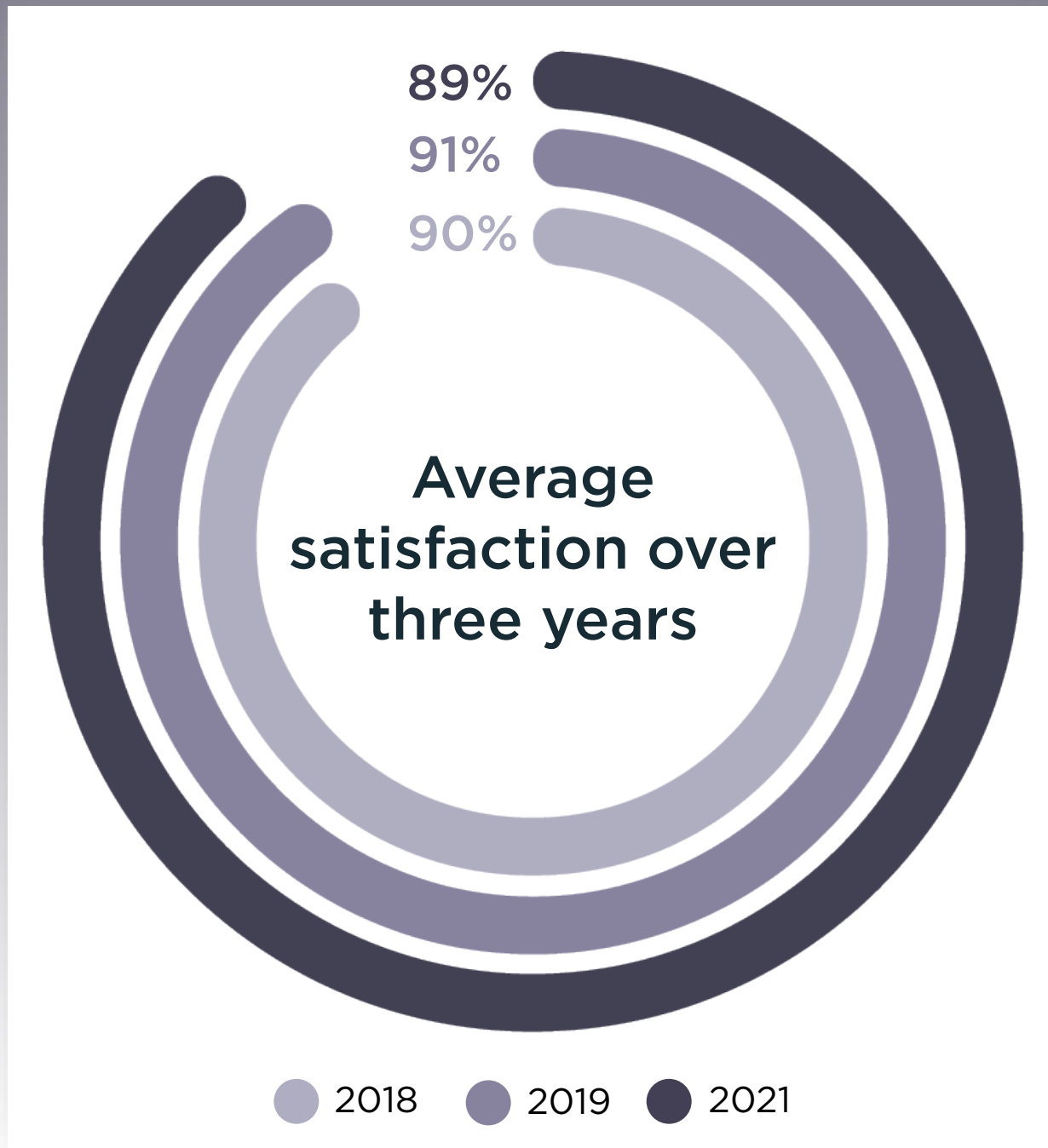

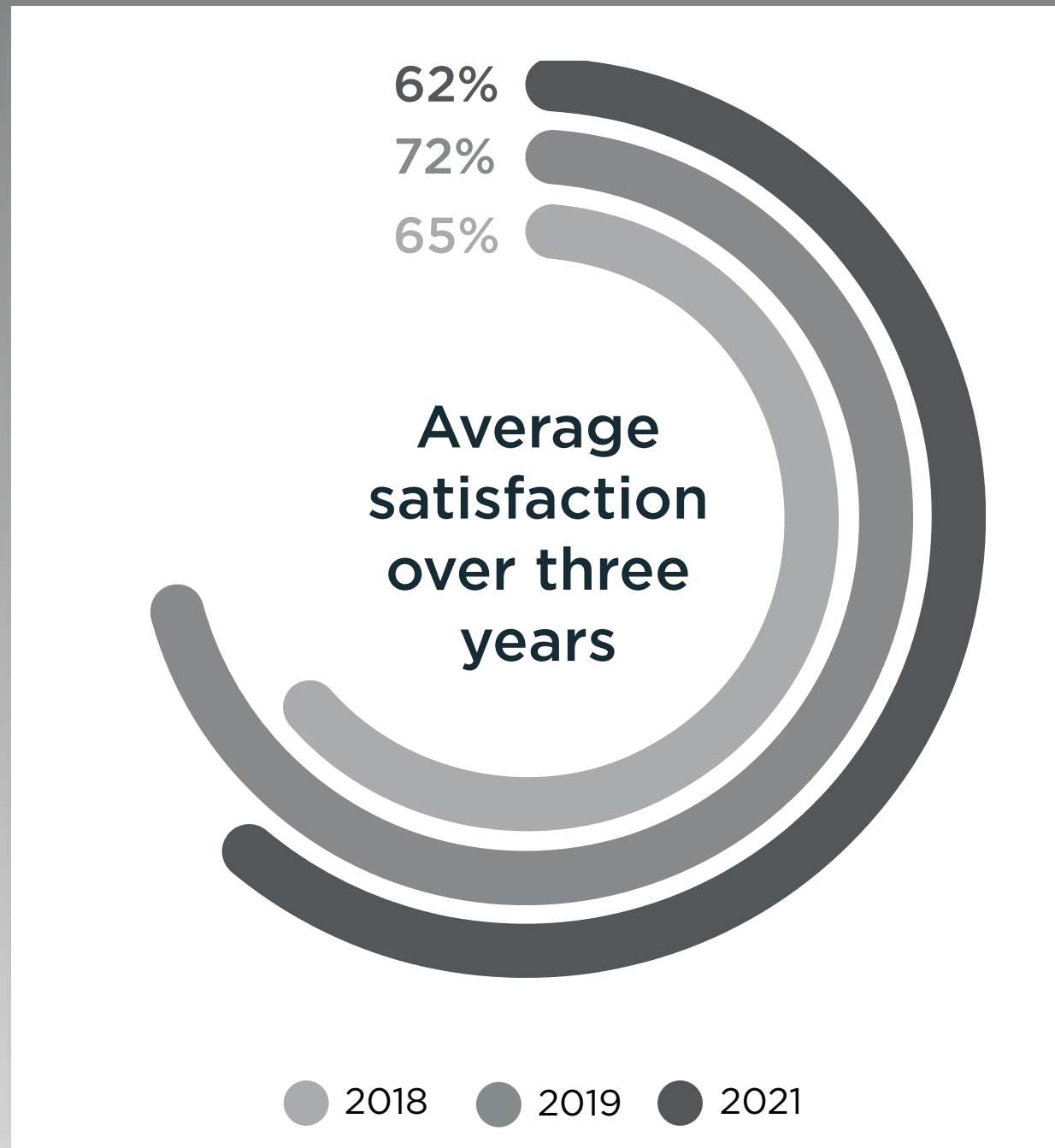

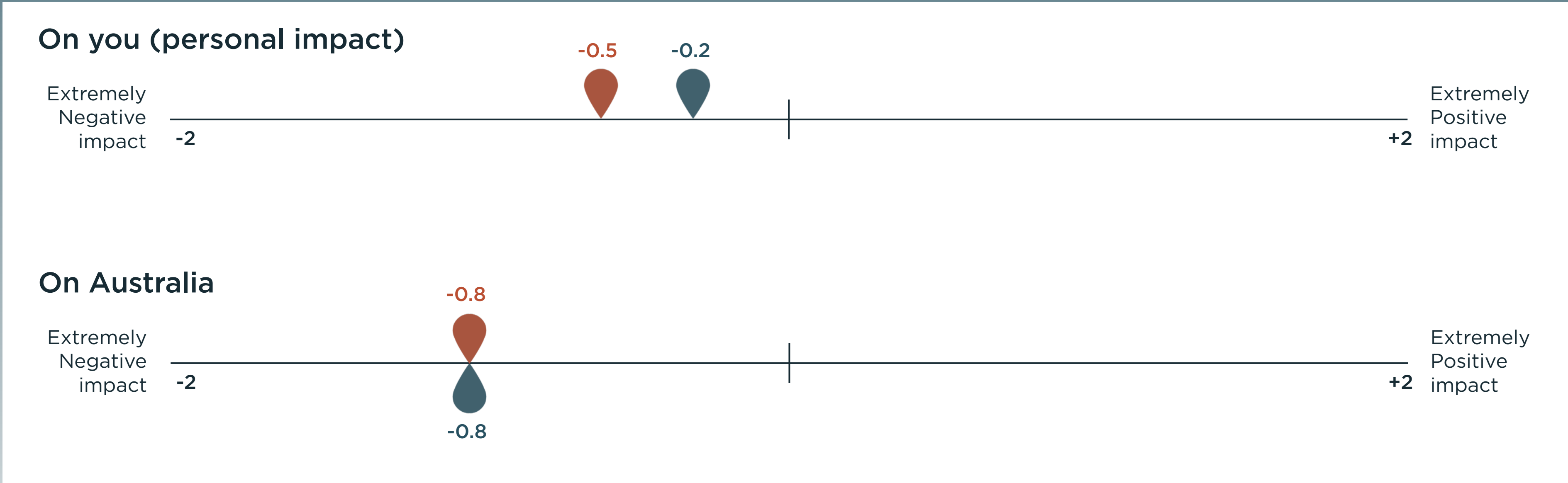
COVID-19

Impact of COVID-19

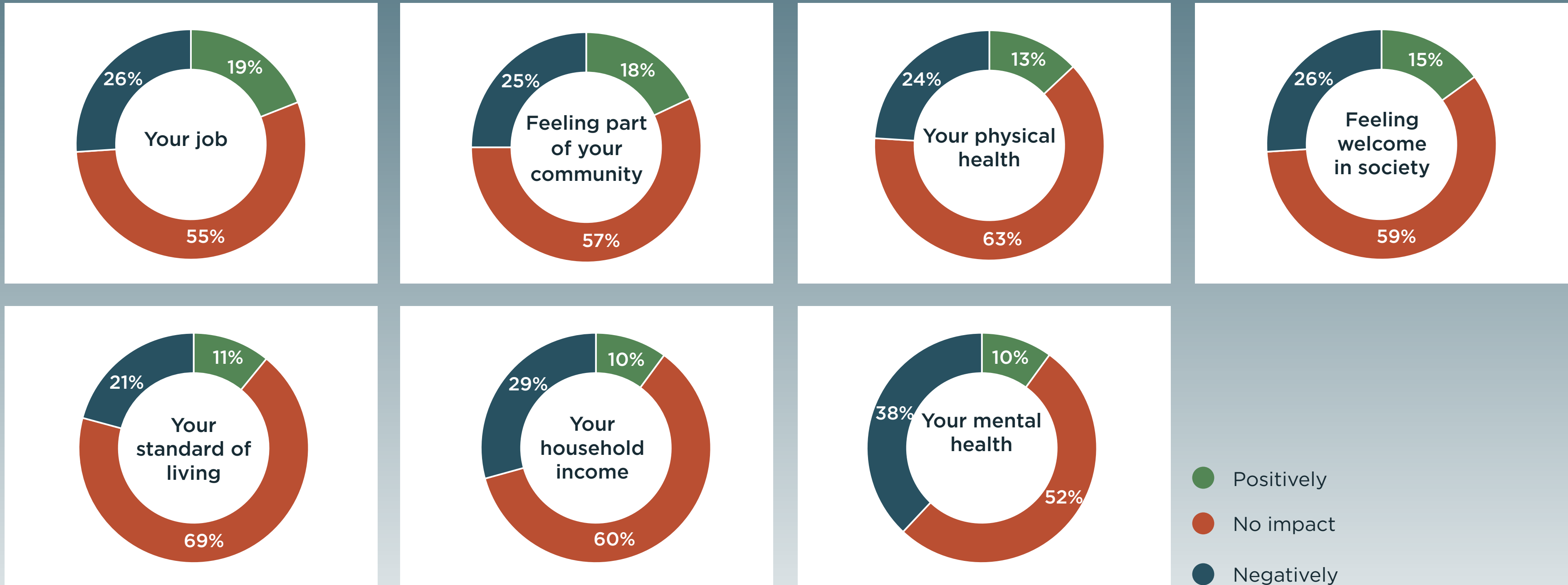

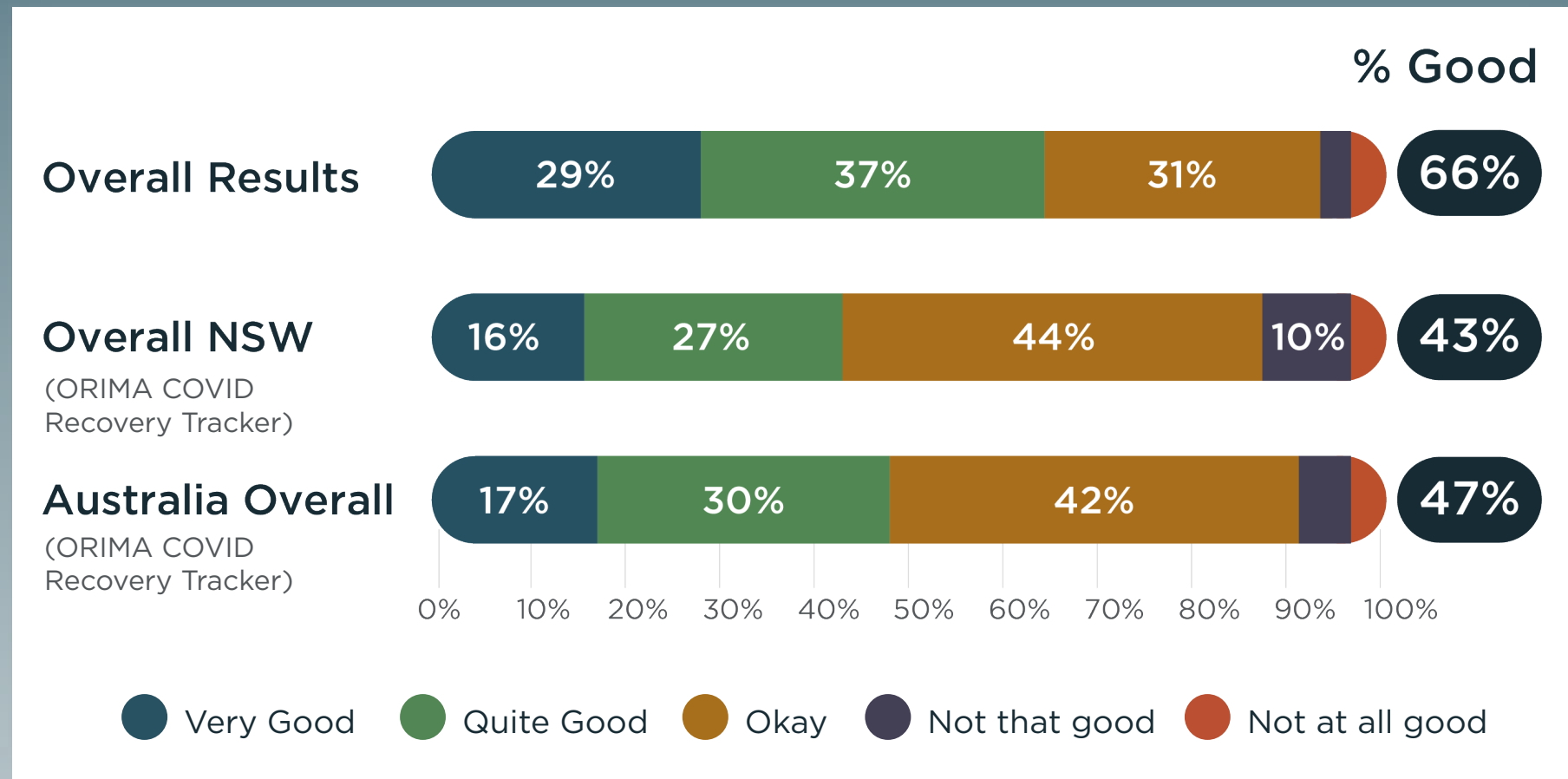

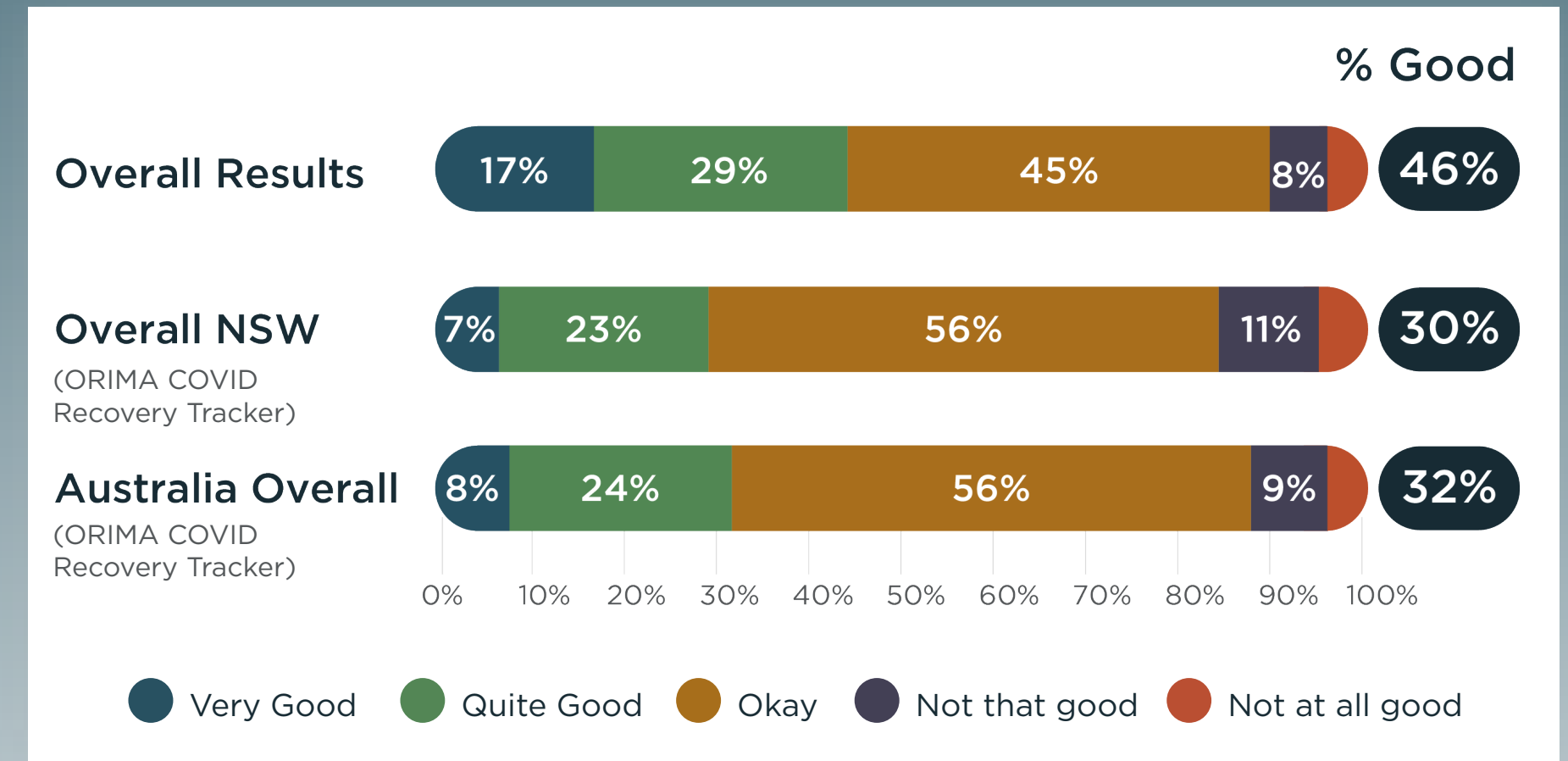

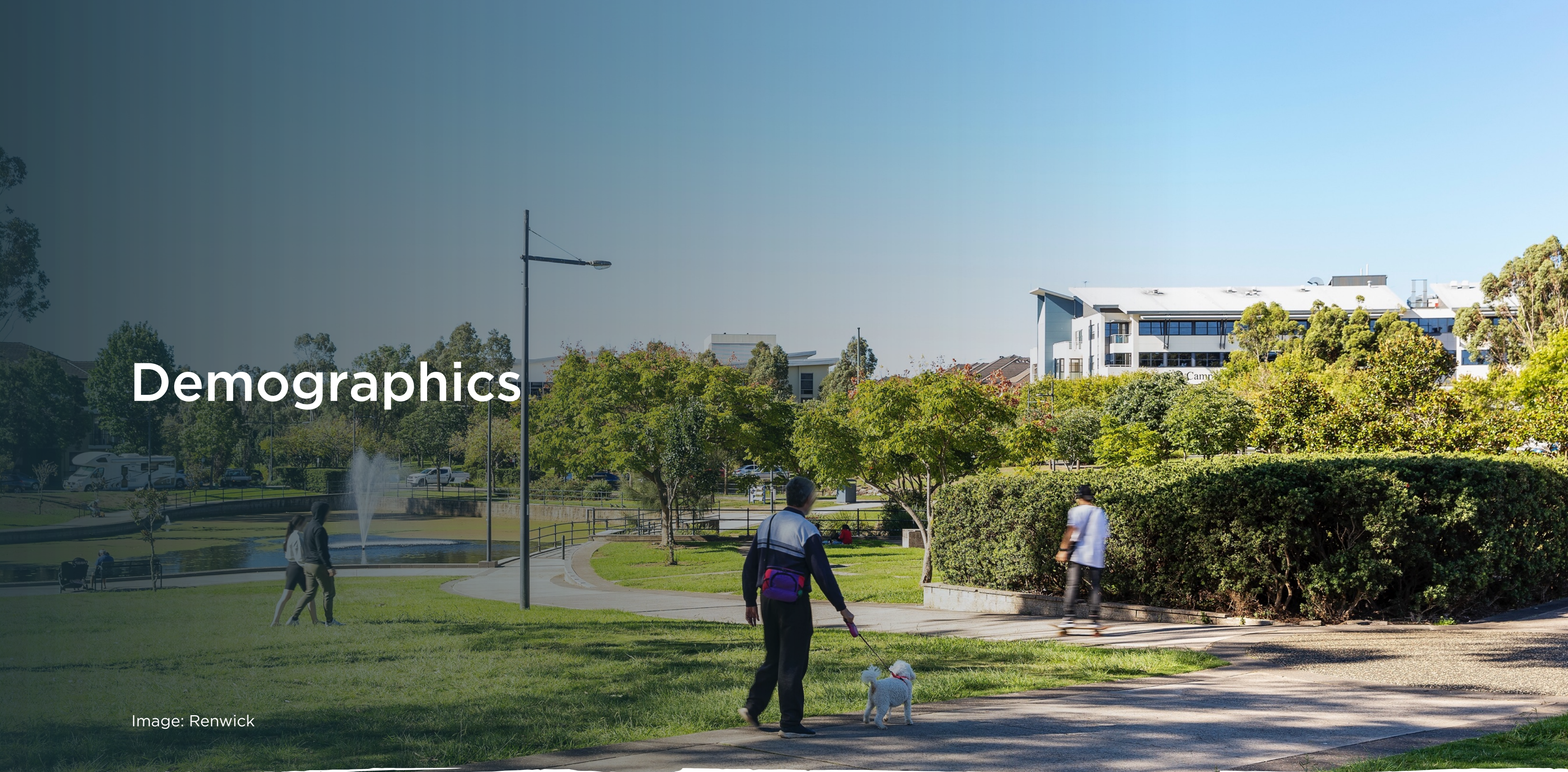
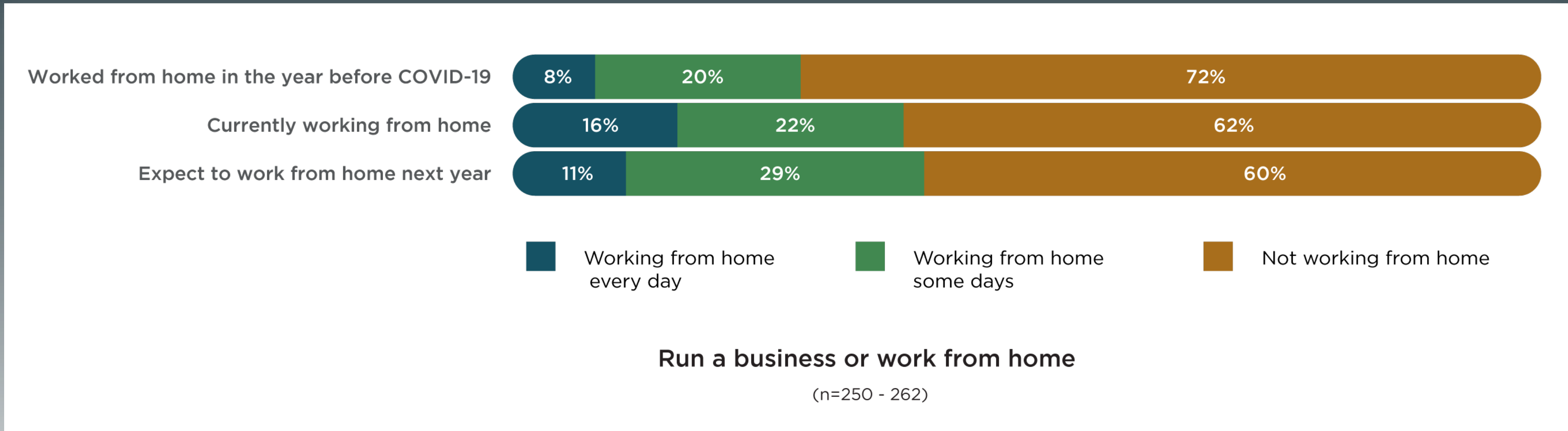

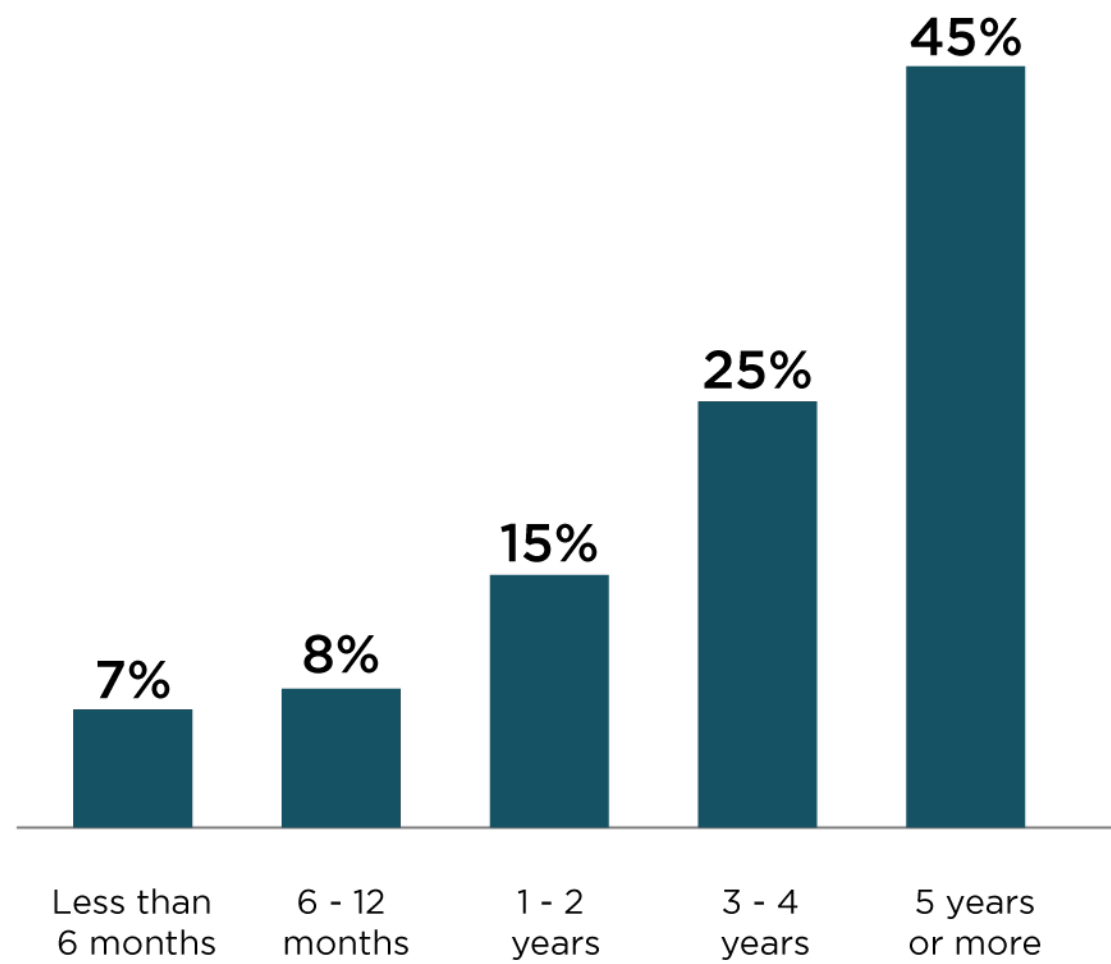

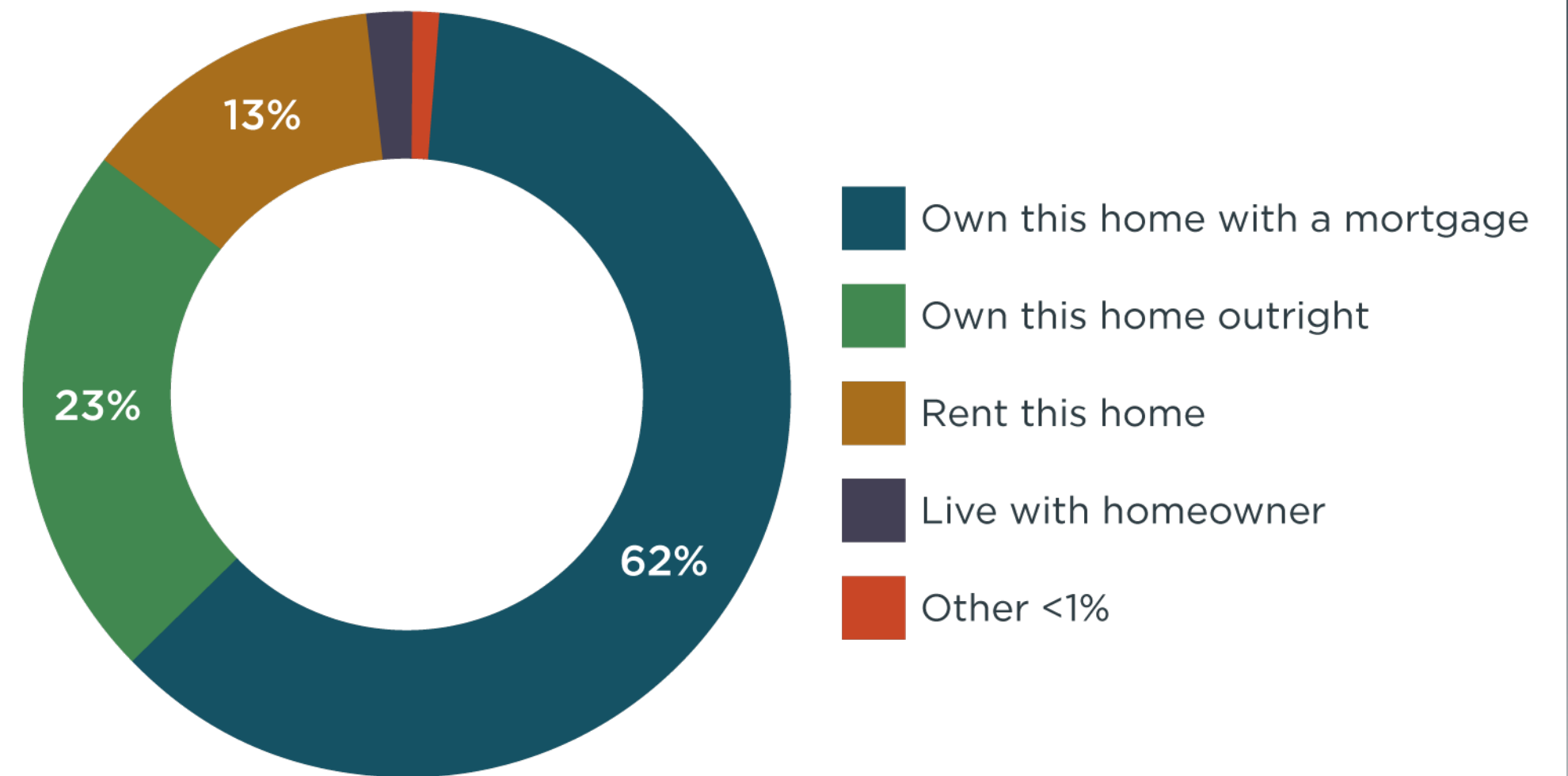

Duration and type of residence



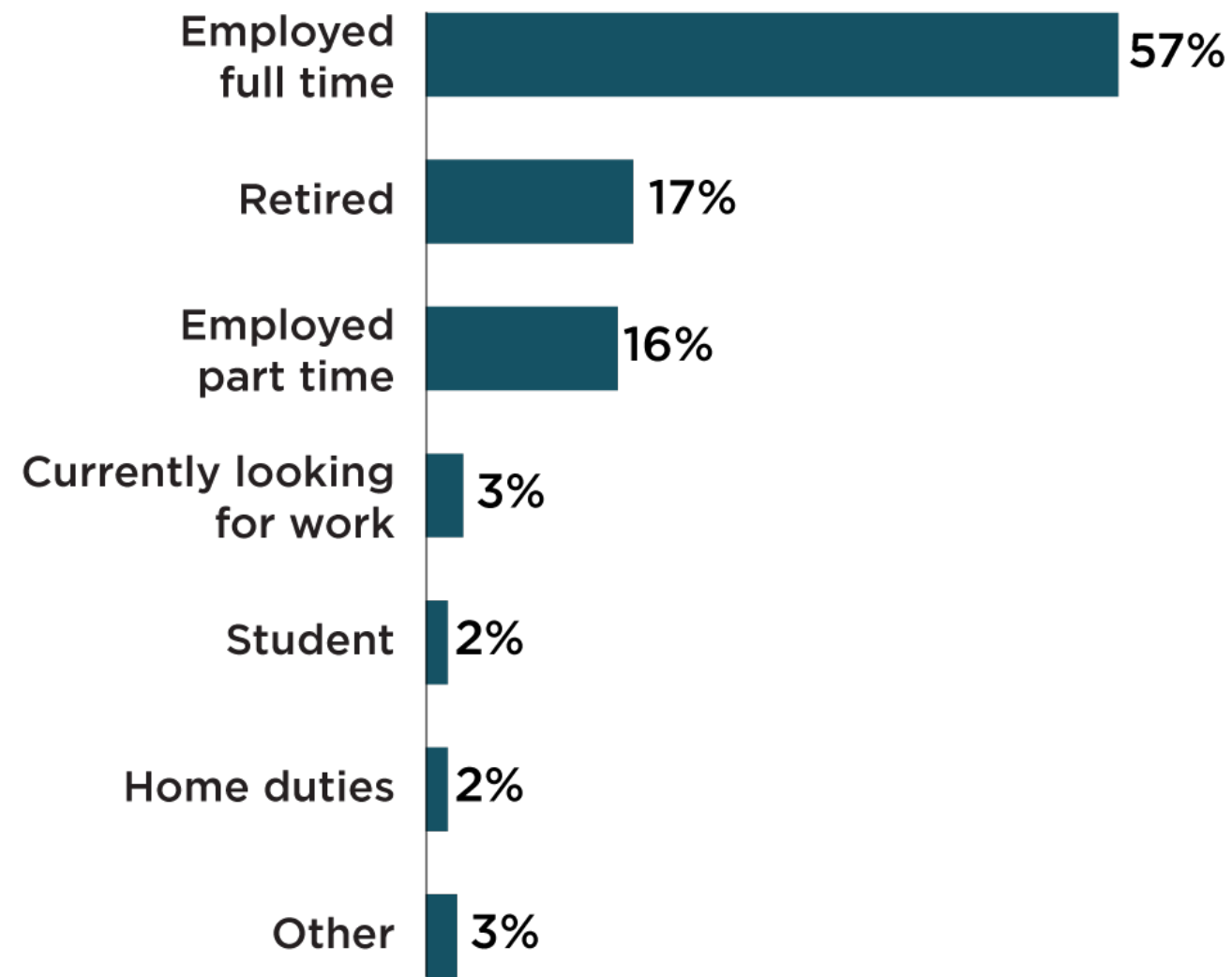
How long have respondents lived in the area
(n=271)



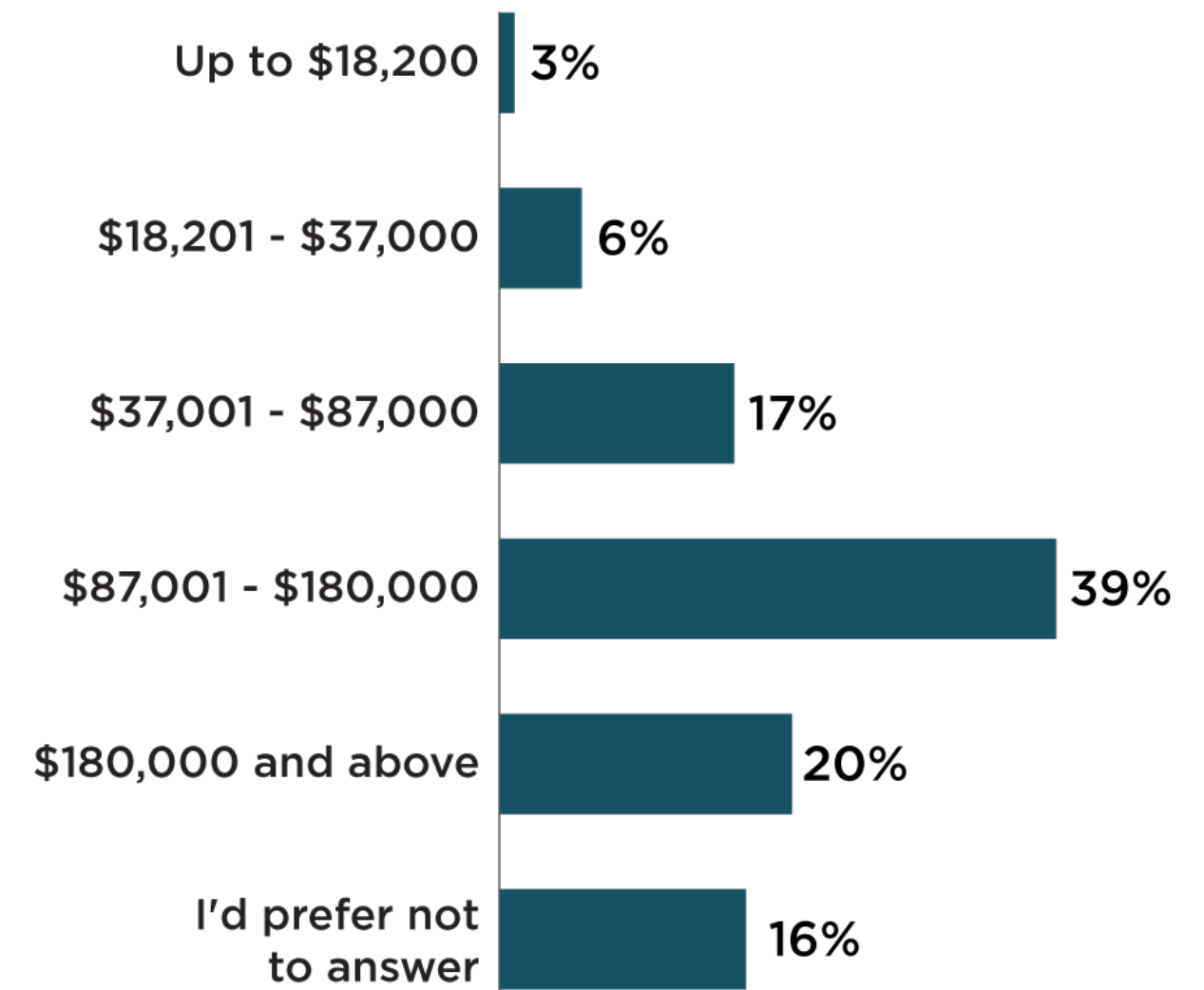
What describes the respondents residences

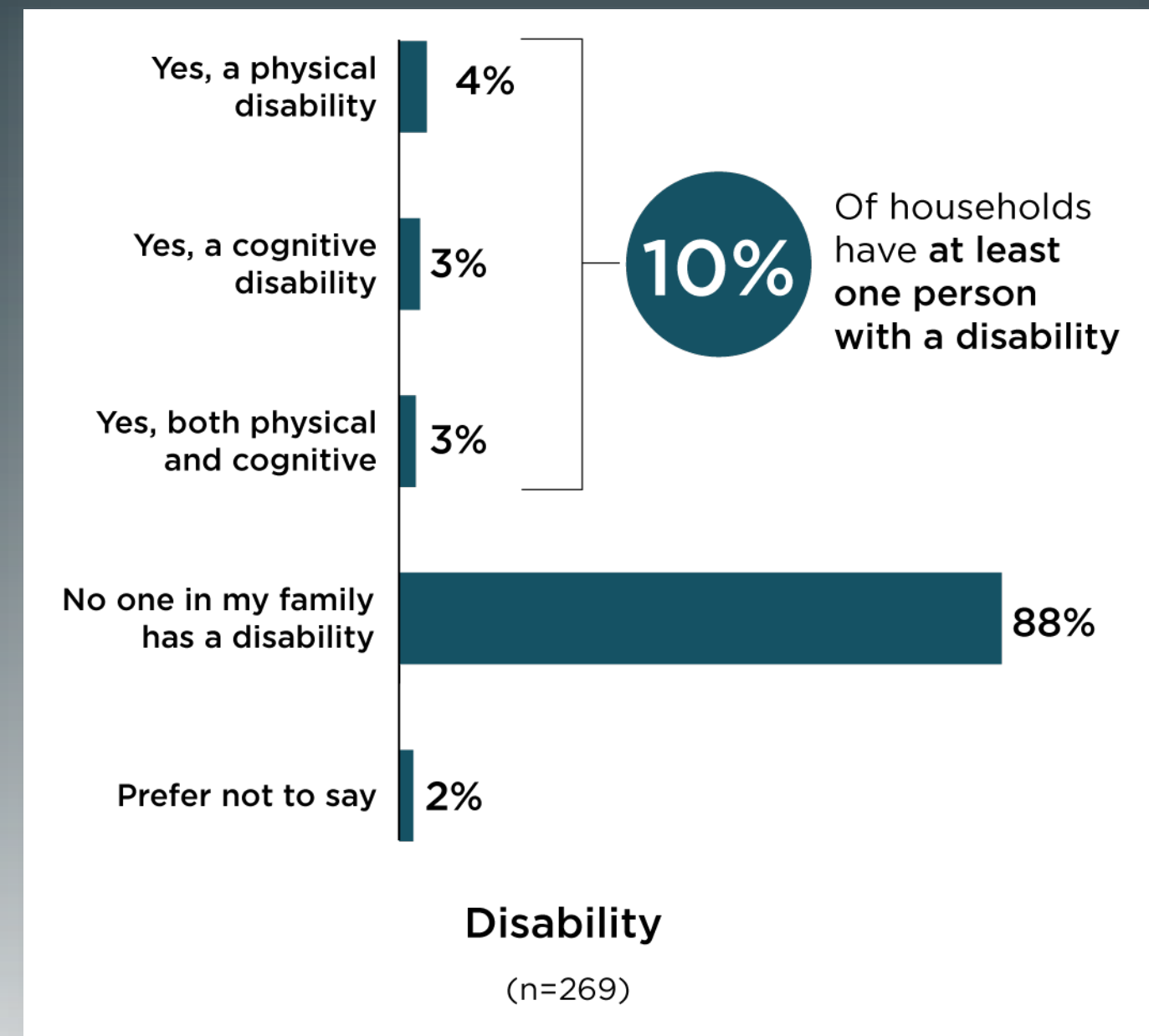
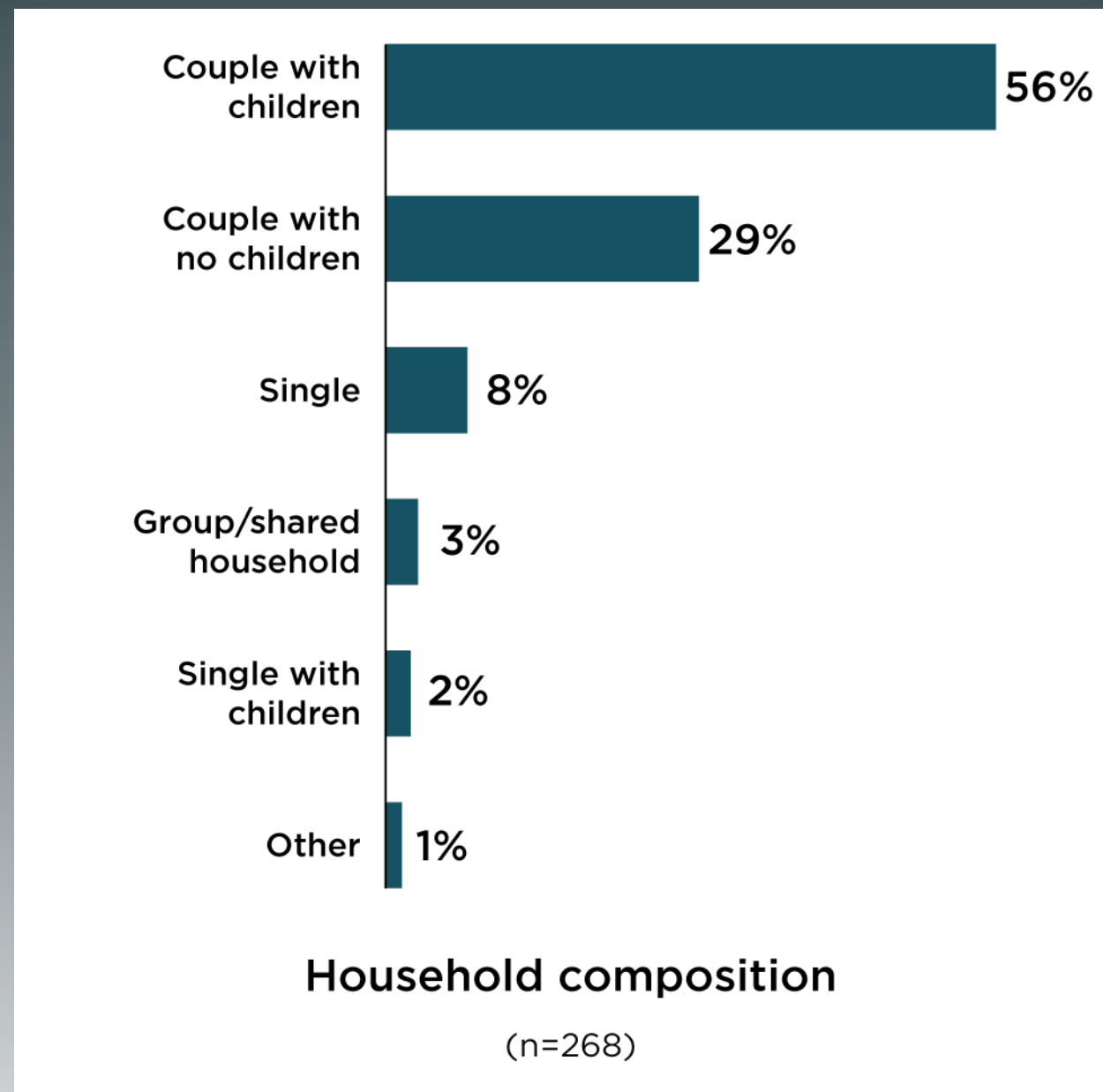
Current employment status

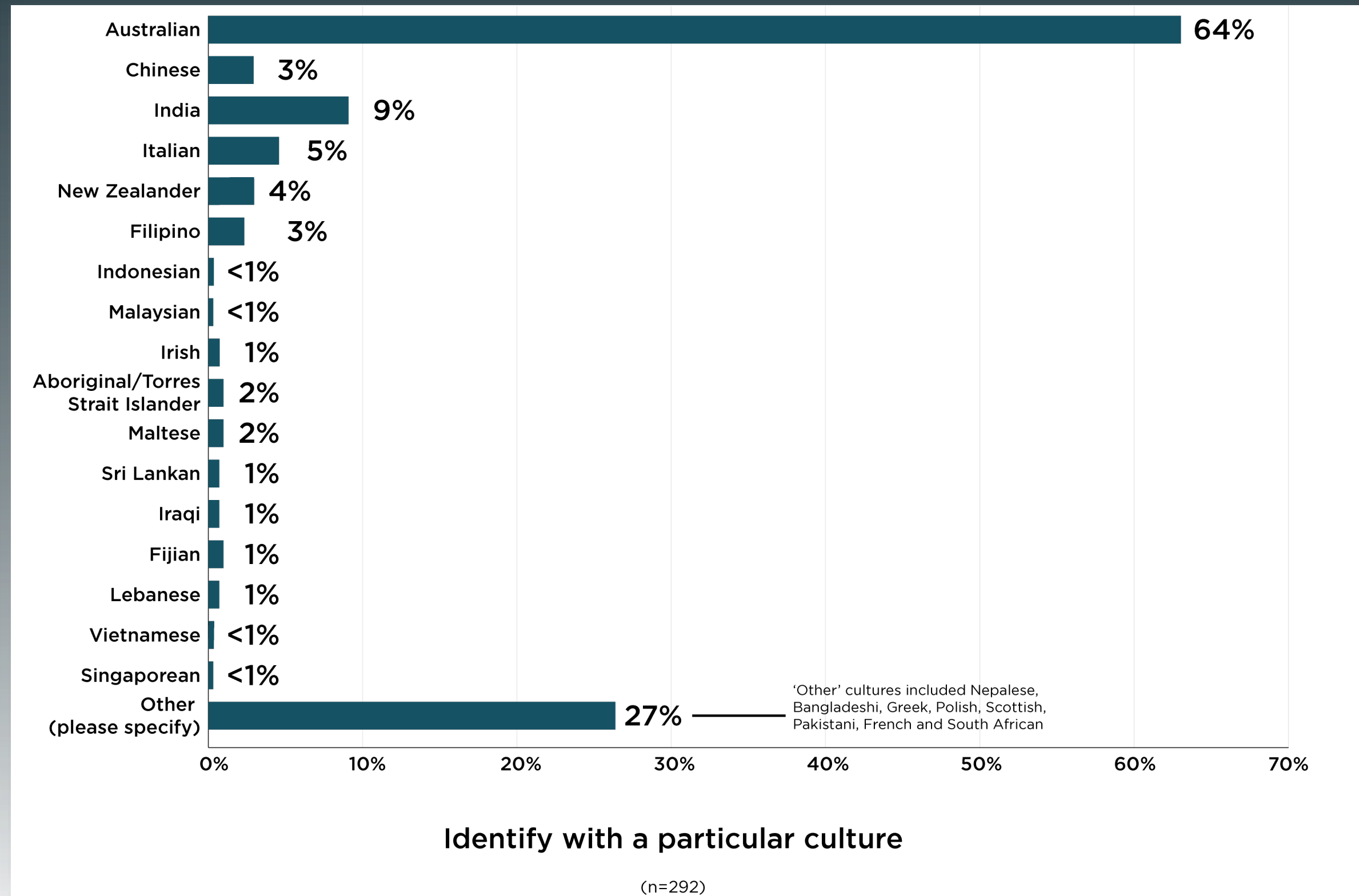
